<p><b><i>Noncompliant Behavior Responses:</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verbal warning</li> <li>• Send a warning letter</li> <li>• Conduct court hearing (Review conditions)</li> <li>• Make appointments while in Project Remand office</li> <li>• Provide homework assignment</li> <li>• Report for UA/BA immediately</li> </ul>	<p><b><i>Noncompliant Behavior Responses:</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• More frequent telephone call ins</li> <li>• More frequent office visits</li> <li>• Provide proof of new address (using a bill or letter)</li> <li>• Must report in person</li> <li>• Send memo to Court/conduct Court reprimand</li> <li>• Provide homework assignment</li> <li>• Sanction conference (case manager and supervisor) in lieu of revocation</li> <li>• Geographic/travel restrictions</li> </ul> <p><b><i>Treatment Responses:</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Increased Urinalysis (BA)</li> <li>• Pay for Urinalysis/BA</li> <li>• More frequent testing (AMP)</li> <li>• If in treatment and relapse; ask for a higher level of treatment (more intensive)</li> <li>• CHA or updated chemical health assessment</li> <li>• Follow recommendations of CHA within one week</li> <li>• Pay for confirmation drug tests</li> <li>• Report for CHA immediately</li> <li>• Give extension to pay monitoring fees</li> </ul>	<p><b><i>Continued Noncompliant Behavior Responses:</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Request revocation hearing: recommend additional conditions per Rule. 6.03</li> <li>• Request revocation hearing: recommend for revocation per Rule 6.03</li> <li>• Request warrant per Rule 6.03</li> <li>• Request warrant: immediate arrest per Rule 6.03</li> <li>• Police victim safety check</li> </ul> <p><b><i>Treatment Responses:</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Increased Urinalysis/BA</li> <li>• Pay for Urinalysis/BA</li> <li>• If in treatment and relapse; ask for a higher level of treatment (more intensive)</li> </ul>
