EBDM HARM REDUCTION GOALS

1. Increase victim and public safety by reducing pretrial misconduct, increasing court appearance rates, making informed release decisions, and providing effective conditions of release for individuals who can be managed safely in the community.
2. Reduce harm to defendants and their families due to unnecessary pretrial detention of individuals who can be safely managed in the community.
3. Achieve greater financial return on investment in treatment, rehabilitation, and alternatives to incarceration.
4. Reduce recidivism by 5% in community corrections felony populations over the next 48 months by improving early assessment practices and properly matching offenders to evidence-based programs based on their risk and need.
5. Increase the overall health and safety of our community by focusing on cost-effective, research-based principles to improve our response to, and reduce the involvement of, special needs individuals in the criminal justice system.
